## Order of the Arrow Unit Elections

### Elegibility

- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.
- Have experienced 15 nights of Scout camping while registered with a troop, crew, or ship within the two years immediately prior to the election. The 15 nights must include one, but no more than one, long-term camp consisting of at least five consecutive nights of overnight camping, approved and under the auspices and standards of the Boy Scouts of America. Only five nights of the long-term camp may be credited toward the 15-night camping requirement; the balance of the camping (10 nights) must be overnight, weekend, or other short-term camps of, at most, three nights each. Ship nights may be counted as camping for Sea Scouts.
- At the time of their election, youth must be under the age of 21, hold the Scouts BSA First Class rank, the Venturing Discovery Award, or the Sea Scout Ordinary rank or higher, and following approval by the Scoutmaster, Crew Advisor or Sea Scout Skipper, be elected by the youth members of their unit.
- Adults (age 21 or older) who meet the camping requirements may be selected following nomination to and approval by the lodge adult selection committee.

### Election Process

An election Team will be present when you schedule your Camp Promotion starting in Jan. You will be asked to complete and sign the eligibility section of the Unit Election Report. These names will be presented to your unit for their consideration. You **must** have 50% of your active registered youth present in order to conduct the election. We ask that you spend a few moments to inform your unit on the purpose of the Order of the Arrow and the basis for which they should make their selection. (The OA team will be glad to do this with your permission)

Each Member of your unit may cast a ballot with any combination of eligible scouts that they feel are worthy of the Order. The OA election team will gather the ballots and tally them. Any and all scouts that receive votes 50% or greater of the number of ballots collected are elected. The results will be revealed at this time or at a location of the troops choosing, like an upcoming camporee etc.

### Adult Selection Process

If the Unit has elected at least one member then the unit may submit one adult leader for candidacy in the Order of the Arrow and no more than 1/3 of the youth elected. The adult application must be completed and signed by the Unit Committee Chairman, should be submitted during the unit election. The Lodge Adult Selection Committee reviews all adult applications. This committee consists of the Lodge Advisor, the Chairman of the Council Camping Committee, and the Lodge Staff advisor. Selected Adults will be tapped out at the OA campfire during summer camp.
